

Hebrews 8

In the past weeks we were presented with a number of facts but the main subject was highlighted in the beginning.

Heb 1:2-3

in these last days he has spoken to us in a son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he created the world. The Son is the radiance of his glory and the representation of his essence, and he sustains all things by his powerful word, and so when he had accomplished cleansing for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

1. God is still talking. 2. The Son is His voice. 3. The Son represents God. 4. The Son sustains everything. 5. The Son took care of the sin issues. 6. He sat down.

What are the specifics? They are mentioned in the next 9 chapters.

1. Vs1:6. Angels worship the Son.

Let all the angels of God worship him!"

2. Vs1:12. Creation will grow old but will be renewed, the Son unchangeable.

they will be changed, but you are the same

3. Vs2:14. The Son made like us. If you experience it, Jesus did too.

he likewise shared in their humanity

4. Vs3:6. The Son is faithful over God's house. And we Christians are that house.

Christ is faithful as a son over God's house.

5. Vs4:10. The Son gives us rest from works. No need to know the Laws.

one who enters God's rest has also rested from his works

6. Vs4:16. He is the High Priest of grace. The Levitical High Priest only knew sacrifice.

approach the throne of grace to receive mercy and find grace whenever we need help

7. Vs5:14. We need to be eating solid food of maturity. Is your discretion up to par?

solid food is for the mature,

8. Vs7:24. He holds the priesthood forever.

holds his priesthood permanently since he lives forever.

9. Vs8:6. The Son has a superior ministry based on better promises.

obtained a superior ministry,

10. Vs9:12. By His blood obtained eternal salvation.

he himself secured eternal redemption

11. Vs9:28. The Son is coming again.

he will appear a second time, not to bear sin but to bring salvation.

Conclusion: are you giving the Son, Jesus, your full attention?
